To commemorate 250 years of American history and to honor Kentucky's contributions, Jessamine County will participate in the Liberty Tree Project. The Kentucky Historical Society has joined forces with the Kentucky Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution to plant tulip poplar trees, Kentucky's official state tree in each of Kentucky's 120 counties. The Kentucky Division of Forestry donated 120 tulip poplar trees specifically for the Liberty Tree plantings.
